- Complying with all legislative requirements and where adequate regulation does not exist, adopting best practice procedures that reflect our commitment to HSEQ
- Setting and measuring performance against objectives, targets and key performance indicators which continually drive us to improve our HSEQ performance
- Identifying and understanding the hazards inherent to the activities we undertake and effectively assessing, controlling and managing those risks
- Providing adequate resources and training to support our workers enabling them to understand the vision of "Goal Zero" and allow them to work safely, competently and in an environmentally sustainable manner, ensuring the effectiveness of our HSEQ Management System
